**Pool Work Days:** We need all of the help that we can get for PAINT DAY. Please come and paint for a few hours. We will be starting at 7:30 a.m. on Saturday, April 9, 2011. Come and help even if you can come later or must leave early.

- **Paint Day**.....7:30 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. Saturday, April 9, 2011 (rain date is Saturday, April 23)
- **Cleaning/Set-up Day**....9:00 a.m. to 12:00 noon Saturday, May 21, 2011 (rain date is Sunday, May 22, 2011)

**Pool Opening:**

- Opening day is Saturday, May 28, 2011 (Saturday of Memorial Day weekend).
- Weather permitting, pool hours will be noon to 7:00 p.m. (please see our website [www.robypool.org](http://www.robypool.org) for hours of operation on days Conrad Weiser School is in session).
- Membership cards will be required for entry and may not be shared with anyone.
- Closing day is Monday, September 5, 2011 (Labor Day).

**Parents-A Few Reminders:**

- As required by the Pennsylvania State Health Board, any child still in diapers must wear a swim-diaper at all times when entering either swimming pool.
- Children 9 and under must be accompanied by an adult at all times.
- The Baby Pool is NOT a guarded pool. Please watch your children.
- Thank you for your cooperation in these matters.

**Membership: YOU DO NOT HAVE TO BE A RESIDENT OF ROBESONIA TO JOIN THE POOL.**

**Family Membership**

- New Membership is \$220.
- Renewal Membership is \$220. You will receive three (3) guest passes by paying before Sunday 5/15/11.
- Renewal Membership is \$220 and no guest passes, if received after Sunday 5/15/11.
- Family Membership is defined as including two (2) adults living in the same household and up to four (4) children aged twenty (21) or under, or full time college students, or in the military. The children need to be claimable on income tax return. Additional children after the initial four (4) shall be at a cost of \$15 each.

**Single Membership**

- New Membership is \$115.
- Renewal Membership is \$115. You will receive one (1) guest pass by paying before Sunday 5/15/11.
- Renewal Membership is \$115 and no guest passes, if received after Sunday 5/15/11.

**Weekend Only Pass**

- \$80 per person.

**Individual Senior Pass (You must be 60 years or older)**

- New Member and Renewal Member \$65.

**Babysitter Pass**

- \$35 per person.
- Babysitters must be an adult aged eighteen (18) or older to supervise children under the age of ten (10).
- Babysitters can be under the age of eighteen (18) if attending with an adult who is eighteen (18) or older.
- Babysitters can be under the age of eighteen (18) if the children are aged ten (10) or older.

**Daily Guest Fees**

- Daily Guest Fee is \$7.00 every day!

- Lost membership cards will be replaced at a cost of \$5 for an individual or \$10 for a family.
- Photos of each person will be taken at the pool and put on the Membership Card.
- Membership Cards are nontransferable and only admit the person named. If someone other than the card holder uses or attempts to use another person's card, Membership may be revoked for the card holder, Family Membership may be revoked, and reimbursement for daily pass(es) is expected.
- Proof of age and or family status may be required prior to receiving Membership Cards or at any time during the season.

# **ROBESONIA COMMUNITY POOL GENERAL RULES**

(Please read, sign on back, and return with Membership Application)

## **POOL HOURS & OPERATION**

- Pool hours as posted. (Noon to 7 p.m., weather permitting).
- The pool or any section of the pool may be closed for maintenance at the discretion of the pool personnel.
- The pool may be closed at the discretion of the Pool Manager.
- The use of pool when no regular lifeguard is in attendance is strictly prohibited.
- The use of this facility shall be at the user's own risk.
- Membership cards are to be dropped off at the desk when entering the pool and picked up when exiting.
- Membership cards are not transferable. A membership card admits only the person named.
- Children under age ten (10) must be supervised by an adult. By law, an adult is defined as a person eighteen (18) years and older.
- Supervision of children under the age of ten (10) is the responsibility of the adults bringing those children.
- Adult swims are for persons aged eighteen (18) and over only (babies okay with parents.).
- The baby pool is for ages five (5) and under. The baby pool is open during regular pool hours only. It may not be used before hours (i.e. during swim lessons) or after hours (i.e. during swim meets) except by authorized personnel. The baby pool is not a guarded pool. Parents shall watch their children at all times.
- Borrowed equipment shall be returned to the guard room door.
- No foul language.
- No littering. Members shall clean up after themselves be it pavilion area, a picnic table, chairs/benches, grass, etc.
- No alcohol. Admission will be refused to anyone showing signs of intoxication.
- No smoking on pool property. A smoking area is designated outside the front gate.

## **HEALTH AND SAFETY RULES TO OBSERVE WHILE ON POOL GROUNDS**

- Proper swimming attire required. Swimsuits only. No loose fitting clothing.
- Swim diapers must be worn by all toddlers not potty trained. Pennsylvania state regulations.
- Admission may be refused to anyone with communicable diseases (coughs, colds, flu, strep throat, diarrhea, vomiting, etc.), skin abrasions, inflamed eyes, athlete's foot, and/or persons wearing bandages.
- No running, pushing, horseplay, wrestling, etc.
- No weapons on premises.
- No food, drink, gum, or silly bands allowed in the pool.
- No hanging on lifelines (ropes).
- No dangerous jumping or diving, including but not limited to flips, cartwheels, peanuts, watermelons, and back dives, off the sides of pool.
- No jumping backwards into inner-tubes.
- No diving in shallow water. "No Diving" posted.
- No "chicken fights" or people on shoulders.
- No heellies, rollerblades, or skateboards on deck.

## **DIVING & SLIDING BOARD RULES**

- Posted rules to be followed.
- Go down slide feet first on back.
- NO GAINERS.
- Cartwheels are not allowed on the diving board.
- Sailors Dives are only allowed in the diving well.
- Only one bounce on the diving board is permitted.
- Weight limits for diving board and slide will be strictly enforced.
- No swimming in well while dive and/or slide are in use.
- Exit well at closest ladder after use of dive or slide.
- Parents may not catch children in well. Children must be able to swim to ladder themselves. Lifeguards will help children dive in well at specific times.

## **LIFEGUARDS AND PERSONNEL**

- Respect and obey all Lifeguards and Personnel.
- If a Lifeguard or Personnel blows the whistle three (3) times, leave the water immediately.
- Lifeguards have the right to ask swimmers to pass a swimming test for deep water swimming and/or use of the diving well and/or sliding board.
- The pool association is not responsible for accident, injury, theft, loss, or damage.
- The management reserves the right to stop any behavior it considers dangerous or offensive to others. This may include asking patrons to not use large flotation devices when the pool is very crowded or asking patrons to not throw their children too high/far especially if the pool is crowded. Management may eject individuals or revoke membership without refund.

THESE RULES MAY BE REVISED OR ADDITIONAL RULES ESTABLISHED AT ANY TIME BY THE MANAGEMENT. THE MANAGEMENT RESERVES THE RIGHT TO WAIVE ANY RULE IT DEEMS NECESSARY.
