- ◇ As required by the PA State Health Board, any child still in diapers must wear a swim-diaper at all times when entering either swimming pool.
- ◇ **Children 9 and under must be accompanied by an adult at all times.**
- ◇ **The Baby Pool is NOT a guarded pool.** Please watch your children.

ROBESONIA COMMUNITY POOL GENERAL RULES

(Please Read, Sign on Back and Return with Membership Application)

POOL HOURS & OPERATION

- Pool hours as posted. (12-7pm weather permitting.)
- The pool or any section may be closed for maintenance at the discretion of the pool personnel.
- The use of pool when no regular lifeguard is in attendance is strictly prohibited.
- The use of this facility shall be at the user's own risk.
- Drop off membership card at the desk when entering the pool and pick up when exiting.
- Membership cards are not transferable. (A membership consists of 2 adults living in the same household and their children 21 or under unless a full-time college student or in the military.)
- Children under age 10 must be supervised by an adult. (By law, an adult is defined as a person 18 years and older.)
- Supervision of children under the age of 10 is the responsibility of the adults bringing those children.
- Adult swims are for age 18 and over only. (Babies okay with parents.)
- The baby pool is for ages 5 and under.
- No foul language.
- No littering.
- No Alcohol – admission will be refused to anyone showing signs of intoxication.
- No Smoking on pool property. (A smoking area is designated outside the front gate.)

HEALTH AND SAFETY RULES TO OBSERVE WHILE ON POOL GROUNDS

- Proper swimming attire required. (Swimsuits only. No loose fitting clothing.)
- Swim diapers must be worn by all toddlers not potty trained. (PA State regulations.)
- Admission may be refused to anyone with skin abrasions, colds, coughs, inflamed eyes, athlete's foot or to persons wearing bandages.
- No running.
- No pushing.
- No food, drink, or gum allowed in the pool.
- No hanging on lifelines (ropes).
- No dangerous jumping or diving: No flips, cartwheels or back dives off the sides of pool.
- No diving in shallow water – No Diving Posted.
- No 'chicken fights' on shoulders.
- No heeies or skateboards on deck.

DIVING & SLIDING BOARD RULES

- Rules to be followed as posted.
- Go down slide feet first on back.
- NO GAINERS.
- Weight limits for diving board and slide will be strictly enforced.
- No swimming in well while dive or slide is in use.
- Exit well at ladder.
- Parents may not catch children in well. Children must be able to swim to ladder themselves. Lifeguards will help children dive in well at specific times.

LIFEGUARDS AND PERSONNEL

- Respect and obey all lifeguards and personnel.
- If guard blows whistle three times, leave the water immediately.
- Lifeguards have the right to ask swimmers to pass a swimming test for deep water swimming.
- The pool association is not responsible for accident, injury, theft or damage.
- The management reserves the right to stop any behavior it considers dangerous or offensive to others and may eject individuals or revoke membership without refund.

THESE RULES MAY BE REVISED OR ADDITIONAL RULES ESTABLISHED AT ANY TIME BY THE MANAGEMENT. THE MANAGEMENT RESERVES THE RIGHT TO WAIVE ANY RULE IT DEEMS NECESSARY.
